Burlington Alamance Sister Cities announces its sixth trip to help colleges in our Sister City with the teaching of English. We will work with students at an engineering university. We will have a variety of enjoyable experiences and will get to know a lovely colonial city.

San Luis Potosí is a lovely, *safe* modern city, with a charming, well-restored colonial historic center. It lies on a high plain, 200 miles north of Mexico City. Volunteers fly into the San Luis Potosí airport via Houston and stay at the 4-Star Panorama Hotel (internet and pool), with many points of interest within walking distance.

Our service trip involves five days interacting with students of English at the Superior Institute of Technology. We leave on Saturday, have Sunday for orientation and then work with students for five days. We come home on Saturday, but participants are encouraged to extend their stay and learn more about the area.

We have had five successful service trips. Everyone on both ends has been enthusiastic about the experience. This is a chance for those not comfortable with trips focused on construction, or medical activities, to perform a valued service in a foreign country.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO SPEAK SPANISH. We are usually accompanied by one or more English faculty and/or students, and some in our group will probably have a useful level of Spanish competence.



Total cost has been under \$1,200. Limited financial aid is available. Home stays are an option.
